Purpose of the Role:

The Mooring Master is responsible for ensuring that Trident meets international oil terminal regulations and is in charge of the planning of inspections and repairs related to class certification and local marine authorities.

- Job Function:**
- Load planning and control
 - Acts as Terminal Pilot
 - Follow up of the class certification of the FPSO
 - Direct supervision of the deck and cargo crew
 - Follow up of loading / unloading operations: (from oil transfer to tank washing – COW, ballast)
 - Coordinates with the maintenance superintendent and the OIM the maintenance planning of the vessel's living quarters, engine and pump rooms
 - Keep up to date the terminal regulations and operational & safety procedures
 - Orders and keeps track of terminal's equipment and spare parts
 - Eligible to receive delegation for structural work and repairs supervision
