The 2019 registrations at the French Maritime Academy are open

High-school pupils in their final year who wish to integrate the French Maritime Academy and become merchant navy officers can register until 29 March 2019 on www.supmaritime.fr. The Academy is not on Parcoursup.

The French Maritime Academy trains :

- First class dual-purpose officers, with the first three years in Marseille then two and a half years in Le Havre where they graduate with an engineer-level title (CTI),
- Engine watchkeeping officers in a three-year course in Saint-Malo,
- Deck watchkeeping officers in a three-year course in Le Havre. The students who are not up to standards can attend the preparatory class

The engineer-level competitive entrance exam will take place on 13 and 14 May 2019 in Paris, Le Havre, Saint-Malo, Nantes, Marseille, Bordeaux and overseas territories.

The engine watchkeeping officer competitive entrance exam will take place on 15 and 16 May 2019 in Le Havre, Saint-Malo, Nantes, Marseille and overseas territories.

What is the French Maritime Academy?

High-school pupils in their final year and their families will have the opportunity to meet professionals from the French Maritime Academy to assist them in preparing their admission, in:

- **Brest on 24, 25 and 26 January 2019** at the Azimut fair, Parc de Penfeld-Booth J06-Maritime, Nautique Littoral sector from 9am to 5pm,
- **Le Havre on 2 February at the Academy's open-day**, 10 Quai Frissard from 9am to 5pm,
- **Paris on 15, 16, 17 February** at the Student fair, Porte de Versailles from 10am to 6pm,
- **Marseille on 16 March 2019**, at the Academy's open-day, 39 Avenue du Corail from 9am to 5pm
