The French Maritime Academy will run a navigation simulator at La Mer XXL

The French Maritime Academy (ENSM), which trains merchant navy officers and engineer-level seafarers, will participate in the La Mer XXL exhibition, in Le Carré des Sciences from 29 June to 10 July 2019 at the Parc des Expositions de la Beaujoire in Nantes.

Le Carré des Sciences is a working group made of different actors from higher education and research and who will present the research activities to do with the sea during the La Mer XXI exhibition

Seven institutions are part of it : ENSM, Centrale Nantes, CNRS, Ifremer, IMT Atlantique, Le Mans University and Nantes University.

To this occasion, the public will have the opportunity to discover today and tomorrow's profession as a merchant navy officer and research through games, videos, manipulations and research items around four themes :

- Navigating and exploring,
- Operating sustainably,
- Understanding and studying,
- Monitoring to preserve

Merchant navy officers, ENSM's lecturers and students as well as researchers, will talk passionately about what scientific research to do with the sea is about.
